HOW TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN ARIZONA



VOTER REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

Are you:

- ☐ A United States Citizen?
- ☐ An Arizona resident in the county listed on your registration 29 days prior to an election?
- ☐ 18 years of age or older before the next general election?
- ☐ Able to write your name or make your mark (unless prevented by a disability)?

Awesome! You can register to vote.

Paper Form:

- ☐ Download a paper form at <u>azcleanelections</u>. <u>gov/register-to-vote#paperform</u> or pick one up from your county recorder's office or public assistance agencies.
- ☐ Fill out the form according to its instructions.
- ☐ Mail your completed registration form to the county recorder, or drop it off in person.

Active Early Voting List (AEVL):

☐ Sign up for the AEVL and you'll automatically receive a ballot by mail for every election in which you are eligible to vote!

HOW TO REGISTER TO VOTE

Online:

- ☐ Grab your valid Arizona Driver License or Identification Card.
- ☐ Go to servicearizona.com.
- ☐ Click on "Voter Registration" and follow the instructions.

VOTER REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- ☐ You'll receive a registration card in the mail from their County Recorder.
- ☐ Check the card to make sure all the information is correct.

You are unable to register if you have been adjudicated an incapacitated person or have been convicted of a treason or felony (unless you have had your civil rights restored). For a first-time felony conviction, civil rights are automatically restored upon completion of a person's sentence and payment of any fines and restitution.
