

WHY AM I RECEIVING THIS?

Your household is receiving this Voter Education Guide because you or another resident is registered to vote. Voter guides are sent by the legislative district assigned to your residence. It may be possible for your household to receive multiple guides for different legislative districts if there is a voter registered at a different residential address that uses the same mailing address as you.

WHY SHOULD I READ THIS VOTER EDUCATION GUIDE?

This guide contains statements directly from the candidates for statewide and legislative office. This is an opportunity for voters to hear directly from candidates, not third parties, about their views. This guide also contains official and accurate information on:

WHO SENT THIS?

This guide is created by the Arizona Citizens Clean Elections Commission (Clean Elections). Clean Elections is a state government agency created by voters in 1998. **Voters mandated Clean Elections create this Voter Education Guide and mail it to households prior to the General Election.**

WHAT IS CLEAN ELECTIONS?

Clean Elections is the state's non-partisan voter education agency founded in 1998 after Arizona voters passed the Citizens Clean Elections Act (A.R.S. Title 16, Chapter 6, Article 2) to root out corruption and promote confidence and participation in our political process.

1. Voter Education

We provide voters with non-partisan election information, tools and resources so they can vote informed.

2. Clean Campaign Funding

We provide campaign funding to candidates who run for state offices in Arizona and agree not to accept special interest money.

3. Enforcement

We conduct audits of candidates' campaign finance reports and investigate complaints to ensure funding is used appropriately.

HOW IS CLEAN ELECTIONS FUNDED?

The Citizens Clean Elections Fund, created by voters, receives revenues from: a 10% surcharge imposed on all civil and criminal fines and penalties, qualifying contributions from registered Arizona voters to participating candidates, and civil penalties assessed against violators.

Funding for Clean Elections does not come from taxpayer money from the state general fund.

WHO ARE THE COMMISSIONERS?

The Commission consists of five members, no more than two of the same political party and of the same county. The Governor and the highest-ranking official holding a statewide office, who is not a member of the same political party as the Governor, alternate in appointing Commissioners.

ABOUT THE GENERAL ELECTION

What is the General Election?

The November 5 General Election is a regular election where voters determine who is elected to office, which statewide propositions will become law and which judges and justices will be retained.

Who can vote in a General Election?

All voters registered can vote in the general election.

Why is voting in the General Election important?

Voting in a General Election is important because it allows voters to select the candidate they wish to represent them in office.

In this election, voters will determine who the next president of the United States is, along with offices at the federal, state and local level.

Likewise, the General Election allows voters the opportunity to decide whether judges and justices of the Arizona Supreme Court and certain lower courts should be retained or replaced.

Voters also have an opportunity to approve or reject laws proposed by the legislature and by voters themselves, known as referendums and initiatives. These measures are referred to by their proposition number.

VOTER REGISTRATION

Voters must be registered by <u>Monday, October 7, 2024</u> to vote in the election. Not sure if you're already registered? Check online at azcleanelections.gov/am-i-registered-to-vote.

Qualifications to Register

To register to vote in Arizona, you must be:

- A citizen of the United States
- A resident of Arizona and the county listed on your registration 29 days prior to the election
- 18 years of age or older on or before the next general election
- Able to write your name or make your mark (unless prevented by disability)

You are unable to register to vote if:

- You have been adjudicated an incapacitated person
- You have been convicted of a treason or a felony, unless you have had your civil rights restored

*Note: For a first-time felony conviction, civil rights are automatically restored upon completion of a person's sentence and payment of any fines and restitution.

Ways to Register

Online:

Visit <u>servicearizona.com</u>. You must have a valid Arizona driver's license or identification card to use this service. You will be emailed a confirmation after you complete the registration process.

Paper Form:

Voter registration forms are available at county recorder offices, motor vehicle division (MVD) offices, most libraries, city clerk offices and public assistance agencies.

Voter Registration Card

Your county recorder will mail you a voter registration card a few weeks after you register. Voters are encouraged to verify that the information on their card is correct. Please contact your county recorder with any questions, or to request a replacement registration card. Your registration card may be used as a form of ID at the polls.

HOW DO I VOTE?

Vote Early by Mail

Ballots will go out in the mail on October 9 to voters that are:

- On the Active Early Voting List (AEVL)
- Have requested a one-time early ballot

Voters can mail their voted ballots back (mail by October 29) or drop them off at:

- Designated ballot drop boxes (if available)
- Any early voting location in their county
- The county recorder or elections office
- Any voting location on Election Day in their county (you do not need to wait in line)

Voted ballots must be received no later than 7:00 p.m. on November 5, 2024 (Election Day).

Vote Early in Person

- Voters may vote early in person at the County Recorder's Office or at any early voting site in their county
- Early Voting will begin on October 9
- Voters must bring their ID

Vote on Election Day

- All voting locations will be open from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Election Day
- Visit azcleanelections.gov/voter-dashboard to find your voting location
- Voters must bring their ID

VOTER ASSISTANCE

Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA)

The Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA) ensures that U.S. citizens who are service members, their eligible family members or other overseas citizens can vote in their home states. This guide has been mailed to every Arizona Military and Overseas voter.

Voters with a Disability

The Help America Vote Act (HAVA) requires every polling place to be accessible and have available (and set up for use) accessible voting equipment that may be used by any voter. Additional assistance may be available, such as curbside voting, braille and large print ballots. Voters can contact their County Elections Office for additional information.

Voters can contact Clean Elections to request a larger print version of this guide, or to request an alternative format.

This guide is printed in Spanish to assist local jurisdictions in complying with federal law (Section 203 of the Voting Rights Act (VRA)). WHAT ID SHOULD I BRING TO THE POLLS?

List #1 Sufficient photo ID inlcuding name and address (One Required)

- Valid Arizona driver license
- Valid Arizona non-operating identification card
- Tribal enrollment card or other form of tribal identification
- Valid United States federal, state or local government issued identification

List #2 Sufficient ID without a photo that bears the name and address (Two Required)

- Utility bill of the elector that is dated within 90 days of the date of the election
- A utility bill may be for electric, gas, water, solid waste, sewer, telephone, cellular phone, or cable television
- Bank or credit union statement that is dated within 90 days of the date of the election
- Valid Arizona Vehicle Registration
- · Indian census card
- Property tax statement of the elector's residence
- Tribal enrollment card or other form of tribal identification
- Arizona vehicle insurance card
- · Recorder's Certificate
- Valid United States federal, state, or local government issued identification, including a voter registration card issued by the County Recorder
- Any mailing to the elector marked "Official Election Material"

List #3 Mix & Match from Lists #1 & #2 (Two Required)

- U.S. Passport without address and one valid item from List 2
- U.S. Military identification without address and one valid item from List 2
- Any valid photo identification from List 1 in which the address does not reasonably
 match the precinct register accompanied by a non-photo identification from List 2 in
 which the address does reasonably match the precinct register

Members of federally recognized tribes are not required to have an address or photo on their identification in order to cast a provisional ballot.

A traditional candidate funds their campaign through private donations.

<u>A participating candidate</u> funds their campaign through participation in the Clean Elections Clean Funding program.

Each candidate had the opportunity to submit a 100-word biography and 200-word statement. The statements were reproduced as submitted and were not edited for spelling, grammar, or punctuation. Non-substantive editing may have occurred for layout purposes only. These statements represent the opinions of the authors and have not been checked for accuracy.

WHAT'S ON MY BALLOT?

This Voter Education Guide will not include every candidate listed on your ballot. Clean Elections is a state agency and has statutory authority to print information on statewide and legislative candidates.



Judges, Justices, and Statewide Propositions?

The Arizona Secretary of State's Office sends out a publicity pamphlet to every household with a registered voter. Voters should receive their publicity pamphlet

in the mail before the start of early voting. It is also available online at azsos.gov/.



Definition of Offices to be Elected

Corporation Commissioner (Vote for not more than 3): 4-Year Term

The Arizona Corporation Commission has five members, each elected to four-year terms. The Commission regulates the rates, business practices, health and safety of many utilities. It also regulates corporations, securities, railroads and pipelines.

State Senator (Vote for not more than 1): 2-Year Term

The Arizona State Senate is the upper house of the Legislature, made up of 30 Senators, one from each of Arizona's 30 legislative districts. The Senate can draft, introduce and vote on legislation. Along with the House, the Senate approves the state's annual budget. The Senate can place measures on the ballot for voter approval.

State House of Representative (Vote for not more than 2): 2-Year Term

The Arizona State House of Representatives is the lower house of the Legislature, made up of 60 Representatives, two from each of Arizona's 30 legislative districts. The House can draft, introduce and vote on legislation. Along with the Senate, the House approves the state's annual budget. The House can place measures on the ballot for voter approval.

Biography: Ylenia Aguilar was born in Mexico and raised in Arizona and rural Illinois. She has served as a Governing Board Member in the Osborn School District, Vitalyst Health Foundation Board of Trustees, and Hispanics Enjoying Camping, Hunting, and the Outdoors (HECHO) Advisory Council. She currently serves as a member of the Central Arizona Water Conservation District on the frontlines of water issues facing Arizona.

Statement: Ylenia Aguilar is committed to protecting rates and ensuring safe, reliable electricity and water. As a dedicated advocate for Arizonans, she was born in Mexico and has called Arizona home for 32 years. Having been raised in both Arizona and rural Illinois, she brings a diverse perspective to her work. A devoted mother of two sons, Ylenia understands the importance of fighting for a better future for Arizona families. Over the past decade, the Arizona Corporation Commission (ACC) has raised rates on Arizona families. The current set of commissioners approved nearly \$450 million in rate increases for residential and commercial customers in the last two years. It is time for Arizona to have a champion for its consumers and its future. Ylenia has pledged to bring transparency, integrity, and accountability to the Arizona Corporation Commission. Biography: I am a native Arizonan, born in Kingman and raised in central Phoenix. Since 2000 I have lived, studied and worked in Tempe. For the last 18 years I have been an engineer at ASU's Mars Space Flight Facility, where I have operated science instruments on NASA's Mars rovers Spirit and Opportunity, the Mars Odyssey satellite, and numerous other space missions. I began my career as an Aerospace Engineer (BSE and MS), but fell in love with the geology work our missions were doing, so I switched tracks and

completed my PhD in Geological Sciences.

Statement: I am running because I believe we need more Commissioners with strong technical backgrounds who understand the engineering and science behind power generation, water distribution, and groundwater management. The Corporation Commission is responsible for making many critical technical decisions, such as the future of our power plants, energy sources powering our homes and businesses, and water security for the entire state. Commissioners need to have the training and experience to properly evaluate the different options and make the best possible decisions for Arizona. With costs and utility rates continuing to go up, we need Commissioners who put consumers and Arizona's future first. I promise to use my expertise to ensure the Commission's decisions will make Arizona's utilities more affordable, more robust, and more secure.

Biography: I have lived and worked in Chandler for more than 16 years. Serving on the Chandler City Council 2015-2023 and serving as Vice Mayor twice. I am a third generation Arizona native, graduating from the University of Arizona with a B.S. in Nuclear Engineering and minor in Direct Energy Conversion. I am also a third generation U.S. Navy Veteran serving as a Naval Officer aboard submarines, honorably separating in 2000 as a Lieutenant. In 2017 I co-founded Cece's Hope Center that improves the lives and future of

victims of human trafficking and sexual exploitation by bridging the gap of services and providing holistic support. I have an extensive 23-year career in Project Management working in Telecommunications, Energy, and Information Technology.

Statement: ADDRESSING INFLATION: Recently, the current federal administration's policy is causing increased cost of coal and natural gas resulting in major increases in the utility rates we are paying across the country. Along with the wasteful use of Colorado River water by California, we have lost approximately 40% of our hydro generating capacity from Hoover Dam. I will work to ensure that only necessary costs of operations, maintenance and cost-effective reliable sources of energy are passed onto the rate payers. ENERGY RELIABILITY: I believe that a diverse energy portfolio is in the best interests of stability and cost effectiveness for Arizona's long-term future. All forms of energy production should be on the table for use. Some specifics are: hydro, nuclear, coal, and natural gas, and in that order of priority for baseload. SECURING ARIZONA'S FUTURE: For variable energy production, which is used to meet peaking and supplemental energy demands, I see natural gas and solar as the two main viable options in the immediate term. For long term, Small Modular Reactors (SMRs) or other forms (i.e. batteries, GeoThermal, etc.) could be utilized once they have been proven safe, cost effective, and reliable.

As the only Commissioner based outside the Phoenix area, Lea has worked diligently to provide financial relief for customers and ensure energy reliability for all of Arizona. Lea recently voted in support of more than \$200 million dollars in revenue reductions in the APS rate case to save money for ratepayers. Lea served as the Chairwoman of the Commission from 2020 to 2022 and led initiatives to rebate \$40 million dollars to customers of APS and TEP during the pandemic, created an energy reliability summit to ensure utilities are prepared for Arizona's hottest days and hosted meetings of the Commission to discuss the California rolling blackouts and its impact on Arizona's energy and utility prices. Lea is a champion for advanced nuclear technologies and cochairs a national nuclear taskforce. Additionally, she has hosted multi agency workshops to improve the status of small water utilities throughout the state to ensure water reliability and affordability for Arizonans. I was securities licensed and trained in investments, ethics, and fraud prevention. My clients were large market corporations and my work involved government regulations, compliance, auditing, and process improvements. I

currently serve as a member of the Mesa Public Schools Governing Board. I have prioritized parental rights, fiscal responsibility, and transparency.

Statement: The Commission exists under the Arizona Constitution to protect the rate payer. Their responsibility is to maintain a safe and reliable grid using the least cost of generation. The Commission is supposed to regulate, not legislate. Forced energy investments and climate goals put the rate payer last and thwart free market principles. The government should not pick winners and losers in the marketplace by choosing products that meet a personal agenda. We must eliminate subsidies and mandates that increase the cost of your utilities. As Arizona grows, we should continue a mixed portfolio of options to allow predictable, abundant, and well distributed resources across our state. An all of the above approach to energy, which includes nuclear, has proven to be cost effective, reliable, and hedges against market conditions when pricing and supply fluctuate. 
