STATE OF ARIZONA PROCLAMATION

CALLING A SPECIAL PRIMARY AND SPECIAL GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE SEVENTH CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT IN ARIZONA

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2025, Congressman Raúl Grijalva passed away during his term as United States Representative for the Seventh Congressional District in Arizona and that office is officially declared vacant as of that date; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 16-222(B) of the Arizona Revised Statutes, upon the occurrence of a vacancy in the office of representative in Congress, if the next general election is not to be held within six months from the date of the occurrence of the vacancy, the Governor shall call a special primary election and a special general election to fill the vacancy.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Katie Hobbs, Governor of the State of Arizona, by the power vested in me by Article 1, Section 2 of the Constitution of the United States of America; Article 7, Section 17 of the Constitution of the State of Arizona; and Sections 16-221, 16-222, and 16-223 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, hereby proclaim and order the calling of a special primary election and a special general election in accordance with Arizona law for the purpose of filling the vacancy in the Seventh Congressional District in Arizona. The special primary election shall occur on Tuesday, July 15, 2025, and the special general election shall occur on Tuesday, September 23, 2025.
