Purpose of the Election: Voters will be asked to vote on a question regarding the implementation of an excise (sales) tax with the revenue to be used only for acquiring, constructing, and financing of County jail facilities with the condition that the Jail District be dissolved, and the excise tax is terminated once sufficient funds have been collected to plan and construct the jail facilities, and retire financing.

Election Day: Vote in person on November 4, 2025 (ballots must be received by 7:00 p.m.)

Deadline to register to vote in this election: October 6, 2025

Date early voting begins and ballots mailed to voters who requested mail ballots or are on the Active Early Voter List: beginning on October 8, 2025

Early Voting Ends: October 31, 2025

Deadline and location for return of early ballots: ballots must be received no later than 7:00 p.m. on November 4, 2025.

Early Ballots may be returned via United States Postal Service or dropped off at any early ballot drop box locations during business hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday – Friday, excluding holidays:
