As you know, on November 14, 2016, Gary Gilger filed a complaint against Arizona's Legacy. After reviewing the complaint and discussing this matter with you extensively, I am closing the complaint pursuant to A.A.C. R2-20-206(A)(3). The matter is being closed for several reasons:

1. Arizona's Legacy has filed the necessary forms.
2. You have informed me that Arizona's Legacy was spending down to terminate as a committee.
3. You have also informed me that at the time of the expenditure, no agent of Arizona's Legacy was aware of the filing trigger because of filing issues with the Secretary of State's Campaign Finance Reporting System.
4. Finally, you have informed me that the committee has done no further fund raising and will complete winding down on the closure of this matter.

**Re: Complaint Against Arizona's Legacy**

Dear Director Collins:


I write today to file a complaint with the Arizona Citizens Clean Elections Commission (CCEC) regarding unreported independent expenditures made by Arizona's Legacy, an independent expenditure committee registered with the Secretary of State (#201400115). Specifically, Arizona's Legacy violated A.R.S. §§ 19-141, 19-158, and A.A.C. § R2-20-109(F) by making the following independent expenditures without filing a report with the CCEC:

- On or about October 13, 2016, and then again or about October 26, 2016, Arizona's Legacy sent out a mailer advocating against the election of Dr. Eric Meyer (and in favor of the election of Kate Brophy McGee), a copy of which is attached to this letter.

As noted in the Pre-General Election Report filed by Arizona's Legacy with the Secretary of State on November 1, 2016, these unreported expenditures totaled \$32,111.38.

I trust that you will conduct a thorough investigation, and that the CCEC will impose civil penalties against Senate Victory PAC as authorized by Arizona law. Please feel free to contact me if you require any further information.
