Re: Illegal Corporate Contribution/Coordination Involving Secure America's Border and Representative Steve Smith

Dear Ms. Estes-Werther and Mr. Collins:

This firm represents Scott Bartle, a candidate for State Senate in Legislative District 11. This is a campaign finance complaint against Secure America's Border ("SAB"), which purports to be a "nationwide group of concerned citizens whose mission is to secure our southern border and defend our sovereignty," and Representative Steve Smith, who is also a candidate for State Senate in Legislative District 11. *See* "No Amnesty Petition," attached as Exhibit A.

Recently SAB sent a mailing to Arizona residents, which upon information and belief, included registered Republican voters in Legislative District 11 who intend to vote in the forthcoming August 26, 2014 primary election. The mail piece purports to solicit recipients to "become a *Secure America's Border Sponsor*" by making a financial contribution, and to sign and return a "No Amnesty" petition to U.S. House Speaker John Boehner. The letter states it was "not printed or paid for by the government." The letter also provides a P.O. Box in Pueblo, Colorado and directs recipients to www.secureamericasborder.com. However, there is no such website in operation. A domain search reveals the website expired in August 2014, and originally had been registered by "Eberle Communications Group"—a Virginia-based political fundraising firm. *See* Exhibit B; *see also* http://www.eberleassociates.com/case-studies.asp#SJ.

However, the letterhead is captioned "Representative Steve Smith (R-AZ), Author of Legislation to Build Secure Fencing with Private Funding." The letter goes on to prominently set forth Rep. Smith's position on illegal immigration and amnesty, including:

> "I am fed up with President Obama's unwillingness to secure our borders and deport illegal aliens as required by law. That's why I authored an Arizona law that secures our southern border with private funding from patriotic citizens like you. Arizona is ground zero for the illegal alien invasion – which is exactly why were are starting here. My legislation calls for using prison inmates in Arizona to build secure fencing and for the installation of other technology that will replace vehicle barriers and barbed wire on the border."

Moreover, the mail piece predominantly features endorsements of Representative Smith by Maricopa County Sheriff Joe Arpaio, and displays an article about Governor Jan Brewer's support for Rep. Smith's border fence bill. All references in this context involve Representative Smith, not SAB or its fundraising efforts.

Finally, all funds raised by this letter are to be sent to "Attention: Representative Steve Smith." See Exhibit A.

Until six weeks ago, however, SAB was a defunct organization: the Arizona Corporation Commission only reinstated SAB as a corporation on July 7, 2014. See Exhibit C. Corporation Commission records also demonstrate that Representative Smith is a director with SAB and serves as its President. See Exhibit D. Until three weeks ago, Representative Smith was also identified as SAB's statutory agent as well. See Exhibit E. Thus, Representative Smith ostensibly signed a fundraising letter for a non-profit corporation that he personally controls, which in turn paid for a mail piece that touted Representative Smith's credentials just weeks before his name would appear on the ballot for State Senator.

For the reasons set forth below, the complainant alleges that SAB has made an illegal inkind corporate contribution to Representative Smith's campaign committee for State Senate; has acted as a political committee while failing to register as one in accordance with Arizona law; and has failed to include a proper disclaimer in its mail pieces. In addition, Representative Smith allegedly violated the corporate ban as well by signing his name to the fundraising letter and thereby accepting the in-kind corporate contribution.

Accordingly, we ask that this matter be referred to the Arizona Attorney General's office for investigation and potential civil and criminal enforcement.



The letter from "Secure America's Border" constitutes an illegal corporate contribution. (A.R.S. §§ 16-901.01, 16-911, 16-914.02, 16-919)

Pursuant to Arizona law, "it is unlawful for a corporation . . . to make an expenditure or any contribution of money or anything of value for the purpose of influencing an election." A.R.S. §§ 16-901(5); 16-919(A).¹ This includes an in-kind contribution. A.R.S. § 16-901(15).² Arizona courts have described such efforts to influence an election as "express advocacy." *See Kromko v. City of Tucson*, 202 Ariz. 499, 502-03, 47 P.3d 1137, 1140-41 (App. 2002) (discussing the test for determining whether a communication is designed to influence the outcome of an election and therefore constitutes express advocacy); *see also Committee for Justice & Fairness v. Arizona Secretary of State's Office, et al*, No. 1 CA-CV 13-0037, at n.11 (App. Div. 1 Aug. 7, 2014) (citing with approval the Arizona Supreme Court's rejection of a requirement that "magic words" must be present to establish express advocacy).

Arizona law defines express advocacy to include public communications that advocate the election of a particular candidate:

(A) For the purposes of this [campaign finance] chapter, "expressly advocates" means:

. . .

(2) Making a general public communication, such as in . . . a direct mailer referring to one or more clearly identified candidates and targeted to the electorate of that candidate(s) that in context can have no reasonable meaning other than to advocate the election or defeat of the candidate(s), as evidenced by factors such as the presentation of the candidate(s) in a favorable . . . light, the targeting, placement or timing of the communication or the inclusion of statements of the candidate[.]

¹ A.R.S. § 16-919(A), and its prohibition on corporate expenditures or contributions made for the purpose of influencing an election, does not apply to "political committees that are incorporated pursuant to title 10, chapters 24 through 40." A.R.S. 16-919(A). This carve-out does not save SAB, however, as it has failed to register as a political committee.

² While A.R.S. § 16-901(5)(b)(vi) excludes "independent expenditures" from the definition of "contribution," that exception is inapplicable here since it requires that the expenditure be made "without cooperation or consultation with any candidate or committee or agent of the candidate and that is not made in concert with or at the request or suggestion of a candidate." A.R.S. § 16-901(14). Where the communication itself is signed (and perhaps written) by the candidate, and the candidate controls the non-profit corporation responsible for the communication, there can be no reasonable argument that SAB's mail piece constituted an independent expenditure.



A.R.S. 16-901.01(A)(2).³

Here, the mail piece not only refers to Representative Smith, it includes a letter signed by Representative Smith himself, contains an endorsement by Sheriff Arpaio, and requests that funds be sent to the attention of Representative Smith. The mailing repeatedly touts Representative Smith's position on immigration and border security and his corresponding criticisms of the Obama Administration, which are key issues in the Legislative District 11 race. Furthermore, the timing reflects that this mail piece was intended to have an electoral impact: SAB was reauthorized to operate in Arizona on July 7, 2014, the mailer hit Arizona mailboxes just in time for the August primary, and now the website is no longer functional. It is clear that this public communication constituted express advocacy that was intended to influence an election.

Express advocacy by a corporation (outside the context of an independent expenditure) constitutes an in-kind contribution to the benefitted candidate, which is illegal under Arizona law. A.R.S. § 16-919(A). The penalty for violating this statute are harsh, as "[a] corporation . . . that violates this section is guilty of a class 2 misdemeanor." A.R.S. § 16-919(D).

Representative Smith allegedly violated Arizona law by accepting SAB's contribution. (A.R.S. § 16-919)

A.R.S. 16-919 not only prohibits SAB's in-kind contribution, it also makes it illegal for "a candidate or a candidate's campaign committee to accept any contribution of money or anything of value from a corporation or a limited liability company for the purpose of influencing an election."

The same analysis set forth above applies here and mandates a finding that Representative Smith has violated the statute as well. It is axiomatic that Representative Smith "accepted" SAB's in-kind contribution because he signed the letter. Furthermore, he personally controls SAB and therefore also "effected" the in-kind contribution on SAB's behalf. Arizona law provides that "[t]he person through whom the violation is effected is guilty of a class 6 felony." A.R.S. § 16-919(E).

³ The statute contains an exception for communications that present information about the voting record or position on a campaign issue, but only if the information pertains to "three or more candidates" and "is not made in coordination with a candidate . . . [or] agent of the candidate." A.R.S. § 16-901.01(B).



"Secure America's Border" acted as a political committee but failed to register as one (A.R.S. §§ 16-902, 16-902.01, 16-901)

In the alternative, by engaging in express advocacy for the purpose of influencing Representative Smith's election, SAB violated Arizona law by failing to register as a political committee and filing campaign finance reports. A.R.S. § 16-901(19) defines a "political committee" as "any association or combination of persons that is organized, conducted, or combined for the purpose of influencing the result of any election . . . that receives contributions or makes expenditures of more than two hundred fifty dollars in connection therewith."⁴ Among other things, political committee status requires proper organization, registration with the Secretary of State, and the necessity to file campaign finance reports (including disclosure of donors). A.R.S. §§ 16-902, 16-902.01, and 16-913. A political committee that fails to file the requisite reports is subject to the civil penalties outlined in A.R.S. § 16-918. *See* A.R.S. §§ 16-913(J). Since SAB has failed to register and report as a political committee, the complainant requests that you investigate this matter and, if warranted, initiate the process of assessing civil penalties.

"Secure America's Border" failed to place a proper disclaimer on its mailing (A.R.S. § 16-912)

A.R.S. § 16-912(A) provides that a "political committee that makes an expenditure for campaign literature or advertisements that expressly advocate the election . . . of any candidate . . . shall be registered pursuant to this chapter at the time of distribution [and] placement . . . shall include on the literature or advertisement the words "paid for by" following the name of the committee that appears on the statement of organization or five hundred dollar exemption statement." "A person who violates this section is subject to a civil penalty of up to three times the cost of producing and distributing the literature or advertisement." A.R.S. § 16-912(E).

SAB failed to comply with this requirement, stating only that the communication was "[n]ot printed or paid for by the government." This disclaimer is inadequate under Arizona law.

⁴ SAB meets the definition of an association or combination of persons because it has at least two directors. *See* Exhibit D. Upon information and belief, SAB expended more than \$250 to design, produce and mail the public communication at issue.



Conclusion

There is reason to believe that SAB has violated the statutes identified in this complaint. The complainant therefore respectfully asks for the following relief:

1. That the Secretary of State refer this matter to the Attorney General without delay; and

2. That the Citizens Clean Elections Commission find reasonable cause that a campaign finance violation has occurred.⁵

⁵ Representative Smith is a traditionally-funded candidate and therefore presumptively is not within the jurisdiction of the Citizens Clean Elections Commission; however, to the extent the Commission retains concurrent jurisdiction over campaign finance matters pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 16-941, 16-956, 16-957, or A.A.C. Title 2, Chapter 20, Article 2, the complainant files this complaint with the Commission out of an abundance of caution.



Brewer signs bill authorizing construction of privately funded border fence



Frustrated by President Obama's unwillingness to build a fence as promised by law, Arizona Gov. Jan Brewer has signed a law to secure the border with private funding using prison inmates for labor.

PHOENIX - Governor Jan Brewer signed into law Monday morning a bill authorizing the construction of a border fence between Arizona and Mexico.

The bill, SB 1406, permits Arizona to work with other border states in constructing a privately funded border fence, hailed as a major step in enforcing national security.

"The federal government has put states like Arizona on the backburner for far too long, making flawed claims that the border has never been more secure," said Sen. Steve Smith, sponsor of SB 1406. "

For proof that a well-built fence really works, all you need to do is look at the progress in Yuma County. In 2006, Yuma built a triple-layered, 20-foot-tall wall, reinforced by cement-filled steel piping and wire. Yuma County Chief Deputy Leon Wilmot said reports of robberies, smuggling, rape and killings have decreased significantly since the wall construction. A website will be launched immediately by the Joint Border Security Committee and be used to gather donations in order to fund the construction of a border fence.

Volunteers and inmate labor will be used to construct the fence. According to a report, there are currently 6,000 prison inmates available and qualified to assist in building the fence.



