WHAT IS A PPE?

A PPE is an election in which voters can choose the presidential candidate they want to nominate for the General Election.

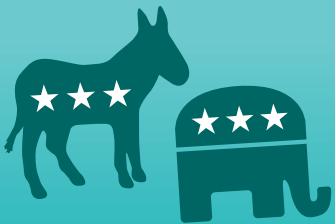

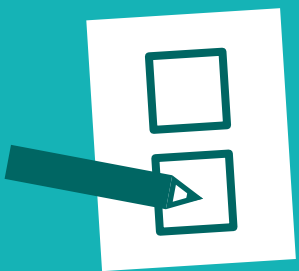
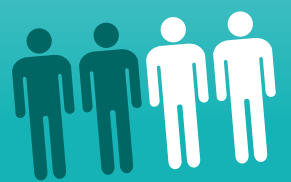
The deadline to register to vote is February 20, 2024

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE IN THE PPE?



This election, only the Republican and Democratic political parties are participating in the PPE.

Only voters registered as a Republican or Democrat by February 20, 2024 can cast a ballot in the PPE.



Voters not registered as a Republican or Democrat **CANNOT** vote in the PPE. Voters that want to change their party affiliation to Republican or Democrat to participate in the PPE must do so by February 20, 2024.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

Delegates vote for their party's official presidential candidate nominee at their national convention, and those candidates are placed on the ballot for the General Election.



Arizona does not hold an August primary for presidential candidates, only a PPE.
